- Don Wentworth, who was one of the DSS contractors, is retiring. They will be changing their contract to someone else in the near future.
- The State takeover of the Medicaid Administration was initially supposed to be taken over by the state back in 2013 and was supposed to be a 5 year transition. Ten years later, DSS is still doing a significant amount of the Medicaid Administration and Ms. Tiberio does not anticipate a significant drop in the workload of Medicaid until 2026.
