4. Office Of Sheriff:

APPROVED MINUTES

Sheriff Cirencione gave the following updates:
Jail Population currently:

- 103 total
- 82 males
- 21 females
- 83 unsentenced
- 18 sentenced
- 9 boarding in
- 5 boarded out

They have done a total of 162 transports in the month of February; 98 to court, 2 to hospital, 35 for medical, and 4 sentenced to state prison.

They have had 6 corrections officers retire since October, but seem okay with staffing; they have 3 new corrections officers starting this month.

He reported on the Solar Eclipse on April 8th. The Undersheriff is working with Chief Lambert along with the jail kitchen to provide bag lunches for the road patrol and emergency operations center on that day.

He said they have launched Prepared Live at the beginning of the week. They have used it four times within the week.

The Chief Deputy is working with Axon who provides their tazers and body cameras. The contract expires at the end of next year, and they are looking at the next 5 year contract at a cost of approximately \$5.2 MM. He said Axon approached them about extending to a 10 year plan versus a 5 year plan, which would come with additional equipment, and technology. This package, by bundling, would save them \$1.6 MM over 10 years. They plan to bring this before the committee next cycle.

They took delivery of two new K9s that are German short-haired pointers for the jail. One K9 was named "Shaver" in honor of Corrections Officer Joshua Shaver and the other K9 was named "Ernie", in honor of former Undersheriff Ernest Kerski.
