Sheriff Cirencione along with Chief Deputy John Falbo, presented a resolution entitled, "Authorizing Budget Transfer for Funding of a Ten-Year Service Agreement with Axon Enterprise for the Sheriff's Office Law Enforcement Bureau 2024-2034".

Chief Deputy Falbo presented and explained why they would contract with Axon as their vendor/provider. They currently have three contracts and would like to combine them into a ten-year service agreement that would include additional equipment and services. He presented handouts with the projected costs. The dollar amount in the resolution in the sixth "WHEREAS" should be \$74,844.42 and not \$212,213.18. He said there would be a savings of approximately \$1.8 million over 10 years. Additional explanation and discussion took place about the equipment upgrades and how they would be utilized. Chief Deputy Falbo also discussed virtual reality (VR) training, Active Investigator Pro related to artificial intelligence (AI), and FUSUS Real-Time Crime Center (RTCC).
