- The governor's budget has not passed yet, but she believes they will be losing the rabies funding grant in the amount of \$37,588. The grant paid for the rabies clinic and vet and any dollars leftover helped with post-exposure to rabies.
- They have permission to continue their public health fellows.
- They are interviewing for a rabies coordinator.
- They are considering a product called Credible Mind to include in the 2025 budget. It is a clearing house for mental health services.

- Many of their service staff have gone remote a little earlier than expected.
- The completion date is expected to be the end of 2026.
- Thanks to the H.E.L.P. program, their caseworkers are fully staffed. On the examiners' side, they are still down 3 positions. She said there are a lot of "green" staff.
- They will be meeting with a trainer to consider what is needed for supervision training.

Discussion took place regarding the work atmosphere of staff and how it affects the hiring and retention of staff.
