Undersheriff Rago shared the following results of the Blue Line Wellness with Dr. Butler:

- In January she conducted 114 meet and greets, where she developed 40 follow-up consultations.
- In February she met 57 more individuals for meet and greets and had 33 follow-ups and 3 family follow-ups
- In March, she had 29 meet and greets and 31 follow-ups.

It was noted that, with the success of the program, the Sheriff's Department may come forward in the future to request more funds to continue to provide this service to its members.

The Undersheriff noted the great collaboration they had with the departments and the State Troopers for the Solar Eclipse.

8. County Administrator

County Administrator, Chris DeBolt, provided the following updates:

- There is a resolution going before Governmental Operations and Insurance to proclaim April as County Government Month.
- Thanks to the Sheriff's Office and EMO for collaboration in planning for the eclipse. He said he felt this was an excellent exercise in preparedness.
