- They officially graduated from the Office of Mental Health's mandatory classes to meet all the five best practices for the clinic.
- They are very busy with the capacity evaluations. They are collaborating with the defense attorneys and the DA. Holly Adams explained this process is beyond taxing for the Mental

Health staff as well as the DSS staff. Chris DeBolt enlarged upon the competency hearings and the term Section 730 evaluations and how it affects the cost to the county. They are in the process of creating a Section 730 working group.

- They hope to purchase, in conjunction with Public Health, a Credible Mind platform to assist with public awareness. They plan to utilize opioid dollars to purchase this.

5. Office For The Aging:

Triciajean Jones, presented a resolution entitled, "Authorization to contract with Purfoods LLC DBA Mom's Meals for Home Delivered Meals".

Triciajean Jones, provided the following updates:

- Through the Older Americans Act, they are required to have an advisory council. They currently have 6 members on the council. She is seeking help to find volunteers to sit on the advisory council. She would like to see up to 10 members.
- They have tripled their community presentations from a year ago. They have worked with the Mental Health and the Sheriff's Office.
- The third caregiver panel is on May 8th at the Wood Library.

6. Youth Bureau:

Marsha Foote provided the following updates:

- She received word that their Resource Allocation Plan (RAP) was approved.
- She publicly thanked those who were able to be at the Youth Awards.

7. Department Of Social Services:

Eileen Tiberio provided the following updates:

- Just as OFA deals with a population of over 60, DSS deals with an adult population over 18 in adult services. She gave some examples of this population.
- Not a lot of impact for DSS on the state budget. The state has approved monies to the counties for case management services for homeless individuals.
- Renovations at 3010 continue. They expected to move the reception area on April 29th, but that is not going to happen on that date.
- She explained the history of the required training for newly hired caseworkers. She said a group of them is working with the state and are hoping to explore the possibility of going back to a regional format.

- She discussed the dynamic of the courts and the challenge in their desire to bring some consistency in how their families are treated by the court.

After the Workforce Development and Childcare awards, there was enough money left over by the recommendation of the committees. They had Harrison Studios engage with those folks who had applied for the Art, Culture, and Recreation grants in

the first round, who were not successful via the scoring mechanism. They were able to identify 11 projects in the amount of \$572,000.

With the housing committee, they gave people the opportunity to have a backup so that if someone can't be there, then someone from that industry could be there to represent that industry.
