95 inmates currently; 70 males and 25 females

15 are housed; the majority are females from Jefferson and Yates counties. 3 are boarded out.

Sheriff Cirencione said the launch of the Handle with Care last week. They did a press release on it. This app allows those who have people in their households with special needs to alert the first responders to those special needs.

Chief Deputy Falbo gave an update on the Axon program at the jail and how it has been positive and successful, assisting in resolving accusations that occurred within the jail.

Supervisor Marren said he and Supervisor Ingalsbe attended the Farmington Victor Rotary last week and Investigator Dylan LeBrake from the state police department was recognized. Supervisor Marren also noted that the Sheriff sent four officers to Washington D.C. to recognize Police Week.
