2. Approval of Minutes:

3. Public Defender:

- 92 currently
- 82 males
- 10 females
- 68 unsentenced
- 23 sentenced

Sheriff Cirencione gave the following updates:

- Jail Therapy Graduation tomorrow at 1:00 pm and invited anyone who wants to attend.
- An incident occurred with the opportunity to use one of their drones, noting how it assisted in the quick apprehension of a suspect.
- They were notified last week by the Commissioner of Corrections and the HALT Act has evolved and they have some ideas for them to potentially repurpose the project a bit. He will have a more thorough update next cycle.

5. County Administrator

Chris DeBolt noted the next two categories for the ARPA grants will be released next week. They are for Workforce Development and Child Care. The deadline for the applications will be December 1, 2023.

6. Privilege of the Floor:

Chief Deputy Falbo, Chairman of the Finger Lakes Law Enforcement (FLLEA), gave an update on the Academy. He said on October 11th, 32 students graduated, six of which are for the Sheriff's Office. He noted Dave Chrysler, Director of FLLEA, will be retiring at the end of the year. Jeff Kyser will be their new director. The start date for the next Academy will be February 12, 2024. He expects the Academy to contract with FLCC again for the training with the exception of a couple of specific trainings that cannot be done at FLCC.

Chairman Campbell reminded everyone about the Employee picnic on Friday and the availability of COVID supplies.
