- They are submitting a HUD grant in the amount of \$2.2 MM to address lead poisoning specifically for lower income rentals.
- They will be offering a flue clinic in October for employees. They will not be offering COVID vaccines this year.

Marsha Foote informed the committee that they have new funding from October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2025. She sent the RFP packet out to all those who got funded last year. She said if your community has not asked for any funding check with your little leagues. They can also call and talk with her if there are any questions. She said they have youth development funds, youth sports and education funds, and team sports funds.

6. Department Of Social Services:

Eileen Tiberio, presented a resolution entitled, "Authorization for Purchase of Scanners for the Department of Social Services".

Eileen presented the 2023 Annual Report for DSS. She pointed out that they put out over \$34MM in benefits to people in the community in 2023. Their \$14.4 MM in co-pays to Medicaid, they purchased \$267MM in medical services for residents.

Eileen Tiberio gave the following update:

- The Board gave them funds to do some contracting to help get the homeless into permanent housing. They have contracted with the YWCA out of Rochester. After she had the "wheels in motion", she found out from the state that they were going to be pushing out money to fund services to move families into homes. The requirements don't match with what they had planned, so they will be expanding the contract with the YWCA. She said the state agency seems to be recognizing many of the issues are multi-systemic.

7. Unfinished Business:

Kate Ott said it is all about prevention, and she said that she loves to hear they are all doing this together.

Chris DeBolt touched on the training at Leader's Group on Neurodiversity.
