2. Approval Of Minutes:

3. Planning Department:

Betsy Landre, presented a resolution entitled, "Capital Project No. H092-22 Emergency Communications Network Core Upgrade Authorization of No-Cost Time Extension Finger Lakes Communications".

Chief Lambert reported there is a third amendment to the Securus agreement. She explained Securus is their inmate phone system that allows incarcerated individuals to speak with family and friends. This amendment is to allow inmates to text. It's called "text connect". It allows individuals who are

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incarcerated to actually use the tablets to send a text message to their family or friends and vice versa. There is no cost to the county.

Chief Lambert gave the following updates:

- Current Population: 95 with 76 males and 18 females.
- 4 individuals are boarded in from Oswego and Yates Counties.
- With the HALT renovations in pod 5, they are waiting for fabricated pieces to complete that project. Once that is complete, electric wiring will be installed and controls for the doors. Once pod 5 is complete, they will move onto pod 6. Sheriff Cirencione said when the pod is near completion, he would like to have a Public Safety meeting and a tour of the HALT project.
- They are on week 7 of 9 for the Corrections Basics School, with graduation on November 1st at 11:00am held at Finger Lakes Community College.
- There is a family and friends day on October 22nd at 6 pm at the training facility.

6. Unfinished Business:

Chairman Campbell noted the following:

- They intend to have a vote on the landfill scenario at the December 5th Board of Supervisors' meeting. He said they are trying to get a decision so that the departments would have guidance on which way to move in the future.
- The employee picnic is on Friday.
