3. Planning Department:

4. District Attorney:

Jim Ritts reported that the Axon contract for body-worn camera footage access and transcription services is recommended for a ten-year agreement. He said all the law enforcement agencies in Ontario County use Axon except for FLCC. He said, currently, Axon links to their case management system through NY Prosecutors Training Institute and referred to it as a bridge. It makes discovery and turning over discovery easier. With the system that is called DEMS, they were talking of shutting down the bridge. The only way to continue the bridge is with a premier program. A quote was

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presented for a ten-year agreement that would be more economical (40-45% savings) than contracting from year to year. They can piggyback on the Sheriff's Department state contract. This quote will expire January 1, 2025. He said if they were to pre-pay out of contingency, it would put them ahead of the game. Mr. Ritts described additional benefits that come with the Premier Program.

Chris DeBolt said that they will bring forward a resolution in the next cycle to approve the funding and agreement.

- Current Jail Population: 94, 73 males, 21 females, 79 un-sentenced, 13 sentenced, 1 on a civil

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violation, and 1 awaiting pre-arraignment.

- Beginning Friday, their presence will be increased at Eastview Mall for the holiday season.
- They have one school left with a part-time School Resource Officer. They told the school their best option was for a full-time officer due to the retirement of a part-time SRO. That position will be run through MCP, and they hope to have someone in that position by January or February.

Supervisor Marren said he would follow up with NYSAC on the cap for retired officers.
