- She is working on creating a list of staffing needs
- They may be at risk of losing their EP funds.
- She needs to get someone off a grant.
- They are applying for two grants to cover the Maternal Child Health position.

4. Office For The Aging:

Triciajean Jones provided the following updates:

- On May 2nd they will have their distinguished volunteer ceremony in The Loft at the Other Half, Lakeshore Drive, Canandaigua.
- They just finished the 2nd of their four-part aging panel. The next series will be in the fall at Victor Town Library.
- There are a lot of things affecting the Health and Human Services Committee. It is at the starting point of negotiations. The proposed cuts are approximately \$9MM to NYS. They are looking at cutting things like chronic disease management, health promotion, health prevention, and their exercise classes. She does not know if they will be absorbed into something else. Another is their long-term care ombudsman program. One of the biggest concerns for her is the proposed \$2.4 million cut to HICAP (Health Insurance Counseling and Advocacy Program), and the other is ADRC (Aging and Disability Resource Center), which is NY Connects. The good news is they have positive state budget revenue coming in.

5. Youth Bureau:

Marsha Foote handed out the schedule for the Youth Awards.

6. Unfinished Business:

Gwen Van Laeken provided some fliers for the Veterans Coalition of Ontario County and the Finger Lakes. It is the only one in New York State. The events are coming up for Military Appreciation Month. They are free for veterans and some are open to community members and with their family members.

Chris DeBolt gave an update on the status of the ARPA Community Grants. He said everything is moving along, and the grants will be fulfilled.

Holly Adams introduced Matt Turetsky, who is in the County Attorney's office.
