Chief Deputy Lambert gave the following updates:

~ Jail population: 120; 92 males, 28 females, 15 state-ready; they are on standby, the state can only take 75-100 per week across the state.

~ The Certificate for Completion on pod 6 is currently being worked on by LaBella.

~ They had a CO graduation on Monday, at FLCC, with five recruits graduating and are now working full time inside the facility and minimizing mandated overtime.

~ Their therapy graduation is delayed; FLACRA has made some changes as far as staffing.

Sheriff Cirencione thanked everyone who made it to National Law Day and their 2024 Annual Report is now available.

6. County Administrator:

Kyvaugh Henry and Gwen Van Laeken presented a detailed summary PowerPoint presentation of the Community Liaison Report. The full report was also provided to the committee for review.

Ms. Henry answered questions from the Supervisors, explaining what food security is and the food gaps. It was discussed that stronger coordination between health systems and community services is necessary to address mental health challenges effectively.
