Sheriff Cirencione gave the following updates:

- ~ Jail Population 119; 92 males, 27 females, 11 state-ready, 10 parole violators.
- ~ There continues to be a backlog of state-ready inmates.
- ~ The HALT Act renovations in pod 6 are complete. The pods have been useful and effective.
- ~ There are concerns regarding compensation for inmates held beyond ten days after being deemed state-ready. They will prepare for potential legal actions against the state regarding inmate compensation if issues persist. The Sheriff's Association is negotiating compensation for inmates held beyond their sentencing period.
