5. Office Of Sheriff:

Sheriff David Cirencione gave the following updates:

- ~ Jail Population: 119 current, 81 males, 38 females, 15 state ready, the state has taken 5 of their state ready.
- ~ They have reopened Pod 5; both pod 5 and 6 are operational.
- ~ The next Therapy graduation will be July 17th at 1:00 pm.

Undersheriff Mike Rago gave an update on the technology grant that will cover the surveillance cameras and license plate readers. They have fine-tuned the locations that they believe are best. The following are the intersection locations:

- ~ Town of Manchester - NY96 and North Main Street (NY21)
- ~ Town of Victor - NY96 and CR42, NY96 and Maple Ave, NY96 and Commerce Drive
- ~ Town of Farmington - NY96 and NY332
- ~ Canandaigua/Hopewell - NY5&20 and CR10, and three surveillance cameras on CR50 (Lakeshore Drive)
- ~ Town of Geneva - NY5&20 and CR6. The Geneva Police Dept. has utilized funds and has put up License Plate Readers (LPRs), where they have cameras at CR4 and CR6 as well as Reed Street and NY5&20.
- ~ Town of Phelps - NY96 and NY318, and NY96 and NY88
- ~ Town of Bloomfield - NY5&20 and NY64

They received \$497,000 and have utilized \$350,000 thus far. They hope to do more intersections, but they would like to make the funding all-inclusive to support the LPR program for five years. The technology has a life expectancy of 7–8 years, so they will look at their CIP next year when they can get the LPRs on a schedule to not have a big lift to the budget with the county.

Supervisor Marren recognized the efforts of the Undersheriff with the program. He also said they are already meeting with NYSDOT for the upcoming shopping season at Eastview Mall and thanked the Undersheriff for his leadership in this.
