Kate Ott gave the following updates:

- ~ The CDC leadership has been replaced.
- ~ Seeing COVID in the US, but not seeing an uptick.
- ~ Immunization for COVID this year; if you are over 65, you qualify. If you are under 65, unless you have underlying conditions, you do not qualify. If you are under 65, you will need to reach out to your PCP to clear it to get the vaccine at a pharmacy. The list of underlying conditions is vast.
- ~ They will be having a flu vaccination clinic in October for county employees. If you are over 65, try to get a high-dose flu vaccine.

4. Department Of Social Services:

Rochelle Gray presented a resolution entitled, "Authorization to Close DSS Petty Cash Checking Account with J.P. Morgan and Open DSS Petty Cash Checking Account with Canandaigua National Bank".

Depending on your service provider, there is the degree to which it is an issue as well as growth. As an example, Wayne County hasn't faced this issue because a lot of their growth is where there happens to be capacity. However, Yates County does not grow nearly as fast, but they do have the issue because of the limited capacity. Jared Simpson said there needs to be a holistic approach to this. Mr. Simpson is asking for any feedback on the draft resolution or if anyone is opposed to it. Any language modifications suggested can be sent to Alissa Bub.
