~ Jail population; 92; 68 males, 24 females, 0 state ready, 2 boarded in, 2 boarded out

~ A follow-up about a survey done by the City of Canandaigua mentioned in the last committee cycle regarding the data provided for the survey related to 911 center call times. He had reported that this company did not seek or receive data from the Sheriff's Office, specifically the 911 center. He said they have since learned that they, in fact, did provide data for this survey. It did not follow the normal flow of how they release data; therefore, he had not been made aware of it. He said their apologies for the confusion on this.

4. County Administrator:

Alissa Bub provided the 3rd quarter ARPA status report of 2025.

Ms. Bub announced that the United Way campaign kicks off this week.

Chris DeBolt asked that the Supervisors start looking for their dog control contracts.

5. Addendum:

Kelly Wolford presented a Resolution entitled, "Rescind Resolution No. 450-2025 and Authorize Acceptance of Extension to SFY 2022-2025 Victim and Witness Assistance Program Grant (NYS CONTRACT #OVS01-C11337GG)".

Ms. Wolford explained that a significant grant for victim services was rescinded, causing concern over funding for five advocates. State officials plan to extend funding at previous levels to bridge the gap created by the rescinded grant.

Mary Gates explained the proposal does increase the county's cost a bit. She said the state plans on providing a new 3-year contract next year.
