Sheriff Cirencione presented a budget transfer authorizing the transfer of funds from their Jail capital improvement plan budget line into reserves. They are not able to purchase the freezers and coolers that these funds are allotted for till next year.

Sheriff Cirencione presented a budget adjustment transferring funds from contingency to the correctional healthcare budget line. These funds are needed to cover the cost of the medications given to incarcerated individuals, especially the prescriptions that help curb opioid addiction.

- State ready transfers - 3 individuals
- Boarded out - 2 individuals
- Boarded in - 3 individuals

Supervisor Jack Marren thanked the Sheriff's office for their assistance with working with the Fisher's fire district desolation task force, especially the help they provided to Bushnell's Basin fire department transition to new radio procedures that they are now responsible for, after taking over a portion of the old Fisher's fire district. This is a change for them as they are now working with Monroe and Ontario County 911 centers.

Mr. Marren also noted that he, the Sheriff's office, and others have been involved in meetings with Eastview Mall to talk about strategies for the upcoming busy season. They feel that they are prepared to handle the influx of traffic to the area.
